

**100 Years Ago This Month in *The American Mathematical Monthly*
Edited by Vadim Ponomarenko**

Professor R. D. CARMICHAEL has placed in the hands of the Secretary of the Association his resignation as editor-in-chief of the MONTHLY, the same to take effect immediately after the publication of the December, 1918, number. His resignation grows out of his desire to have a greater portion of his energies free for the pursuit of his researches. A committee consisting of H. E. SLAUGHT, R. D. CARMICHAEL and E. R. HEDRICK has been appointed to select his successor. [Carmichael's service lasted but a single year. —Eds.]

The name of Professor FELIX KLEIN, of the University of Göttingen, together with those of six other German educators, has been cancelled from the roll of honorary members of the National Education Association in response to a persistent demand from active members of the association, from members of the Council of National Defense, and from others.
