The editors of the MONTHLY wish to manifest their sympathy and to state that the exchange copy of the MONTHLY will be sent regularly as heretofore.

The great military preparations now engaging the United States have materially reduced the summer session attendance at many of the universities. The attendance during the coming year will, no doubt, be reduced in even a larger proportion. This will entail a reduction in the teaching force already partially discounted by the resignations of members of the faculties. A number of instructors and assistant professors of mathematics have enlisted or entered training camps.
